

Academic Requirements Report

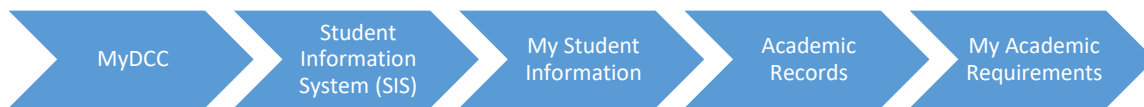
Overview

The Academic Requirements Report (AR) allows the student to track progress toward graduation by showing which requirements are satisfied and which are incomplete. This report includes each program of study the student is currently enrolled. The AR Report does not take the place of meeting with an academic or program advisor. It is a tool to help guide the student through appropriate course selection. Students should run the AR Report before meeting with an advisor.

Accessing the AR Report

Start by logging into your MyDCC account. Your portal is on the DCC homepage at www.danville.edu. Once logged in, select *Student Information System (SIS)* from the menu. Next, from the three available boxes choose *My Student Information*. From the menu on the left of the screen, click on *Academic Records*. Then from the drop-down menu select *My Academic Requirements*. Your AR Report will appear.

Action Steps



The AR Report is viewable directly from the web browser or as a PDF. The PDF presents more information such as a course history and can be printed and brought to your advising session. Click *View Report as PDF*.

Interpreting the AR Report

Important Notes (Web Browser)

Course requirements that are not satisfied are automatically expanded while satisfied requirements are collapsed. To see which course satisfies a requirement, click the arrow beside the course requirement to expand. (Figure A) The key is as follows:




	Course requirement is satisfied. Course successfully completed or transfer credit awarded.
	Course requirement is conditionally satisfied by an enrolled or registered course.
	Course has been planned by student using the Academic Planner in SIS

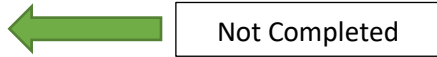

Important Notes (General)

- If you are enrolled in multiple programs of study, the AR Report will show each program separately.
- The AR Report may categorize courses incorrectly.
 - Course may show up under Unused Courses but satisfy a program course requirement.
 - Course satisfies unintended requirement. For example, HIS 121 satisfying an Approved Elective instead of History I requirement.
 - Course satisfies a program requirement in error. This may happened when a course substitution is made.

Course Graduation Requirements

- Lists program of study and whether all requirements have been satisfied
- Outlines all course requirements
- Shows program of study, required credits, credits used, and credits needed
- Students may enroll in more than one related program of study. Each additional certificate, diploma or degree is shown separately.
- Organized by semester for ease of use. Courses do not need to be taken in that order unless the course is a prerequisite to another course. However, most Workforce classes are taught in sequence and must be taken in order.

- Requirements not satisfied will show in red, indicating the number of credits required and the number completed.
- Requirements satisfied will list the course, term, title, grade, credits, and type (see chart above for descriptions).
- SIS assumes successful completion of courses in progress and updates once final grades are posted.
